Because their fabrication process takes days or weeks, temporary crowns are often provided, which may not fit properly and can be uncomfortable.

SAME-DAY (CEREC)

"chairside" or "same-day" crowns

With this advanced technology, your dentist will take 3D digital impressions of your tooth to design your crown, eliminating the need for manual impressions.

The next step involves a high-tech milling machine that crafts your custom crown from a single piece of porcelain in a few minutes. The best part? Everything happens in just one visit!
